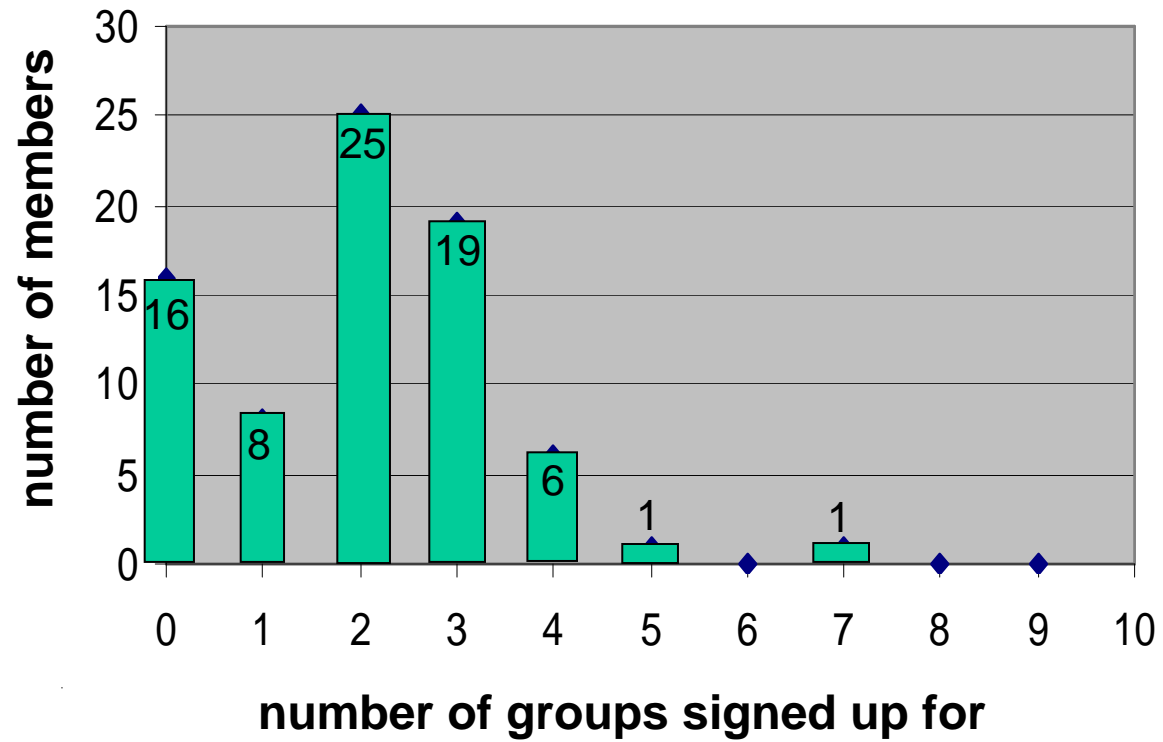

## Distribution of # Science Groups and Members

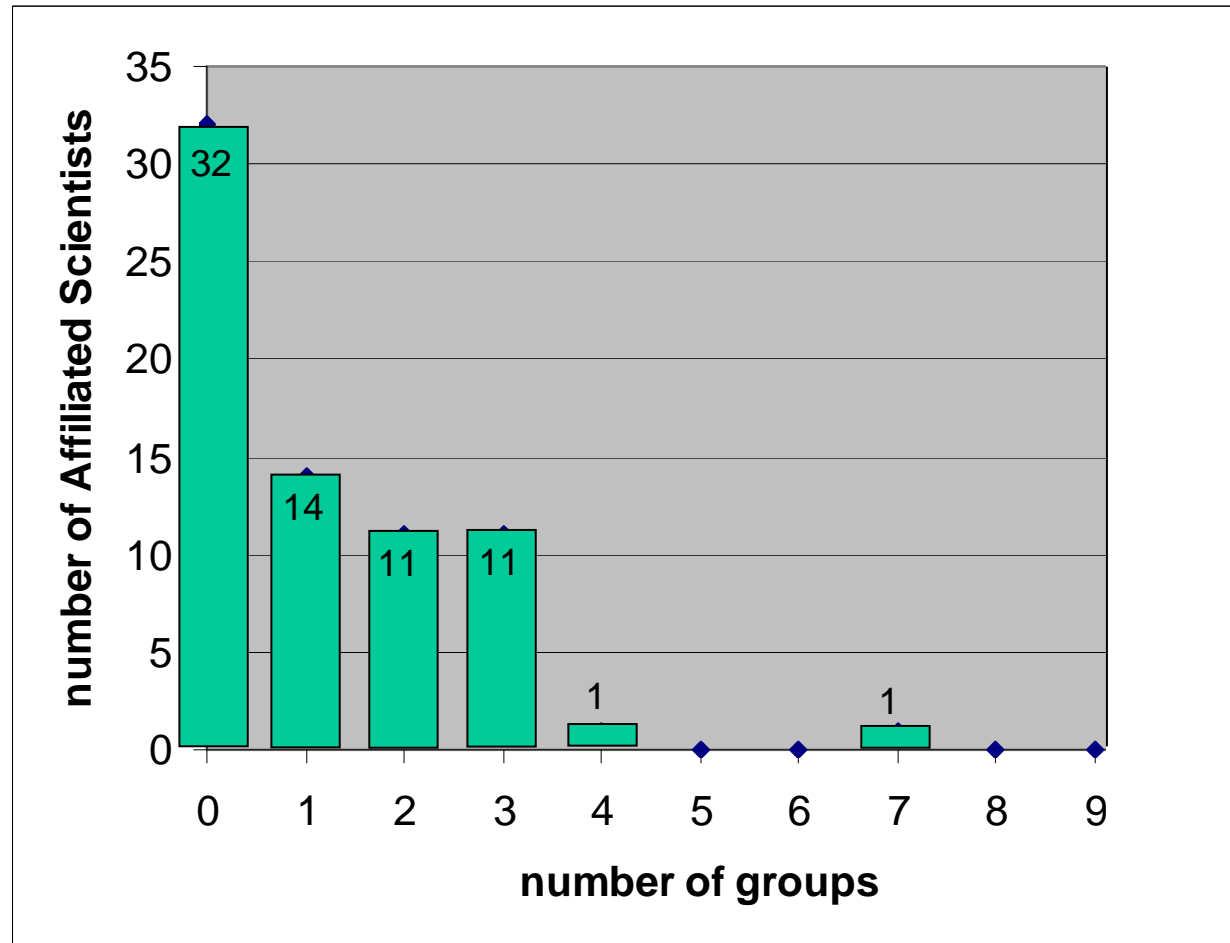
